For your tent, you must provide <u>proof of fire resistance</u> <u>of your tent</u> (per the City as of Jan. 2011). Original paperwork (or tags) of the tent should be sufficient.

• All propane equipment but be inspected with tags. Each tag is good for one year. If not

inspected, we will cover the inspection cost for you as a part of your entry fee. This is for everyone's safety and required by the City of Houston.

- Health permits must be obtained at https://www.houstonhealth.org/media/101/download?attachment. If you have questions, please contact us at ginger.stpat@gmail.com. This form is subject to change in January. This helps reduce costs and give more money to the parade! DEADLINE: 2/2/2024
- Must provide your own Fire extinguisher.
- Propane cylinders must be kept outside the tent area per the Houston Fire Marshall.
- Uncooked meats must be kept between 41-45 degrees... so please check your coolers regularly.
- Prepared Chili and Stew must be kept at a minimum temperature of 140 degrees.
- There will be access to running water, but NOT electricity. Please ask if you need accommodation for this.
- Loading in will start at 8:00 am and run until 10:00 a.m. Vehicles must be removed as soon as possible.
- Parking...open lot next door is available for parking. Please check Venue map on website.
- Please, keep your cook site clean, and clear your site of all equipment and garbage after the event.
- Deadline for entry is February 1, 2024. at the Cook/Volunteer meeting. If missed, call 281-704-7435.
